

Grandparents' Safety Hugs....



Have your grandchild fastened correctly in a tightly secured car safety seat... **in the back seat**...and have your own seatbelt fastened.



Keep **ALL** medicine...prescription and over-the-counter...stored high and out of the reach of your grandchildren when they visit.



Teach your grandchild how and when to dial 9-1-1 or the local emergency response number if different.



When boating, always wear a life jacket (PFD) on a child that is sized for their weight and age...**not an adults.**



When cooking...make certain all handles of cooking pans do not extend out from the top of the stove for little hands to grab.



When buying a bicycle for that special child, also buy a bicycle helmet and have it fit properly.



If you have a pool or hot tub, make certain it is completely fenced...even from your house..or with a locked cover when children are present.



Never allow a child to ride on a riding mower or tractor with you.



Show your love to grandchildren by giving these hugs!

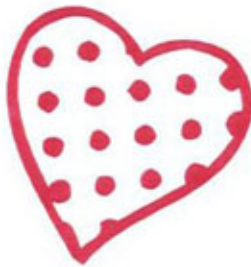
