



2022 Barbara Esposito Excellence in Trauma Nursing Award

Presented by the American Trauma Society, Pennsylvania Division

Barbara Esposito, one of the founding members of the Delaware Valley Trauma Nurse Consortium (D.V.T.N.C.), passed away in 2005. In recognition of her years of leadership and commitment to excellence, the D.V.T.N.C. elected to honor her by awarding a scholarship award, in her name, to a **trauma staff nurse** who has displayed excellence in any one of the following areas:

- Clinical Expertise
- Leadership
- Research
- Education
- Prevention
- Outreach
- Patient Advocacy

This scholarship is now administered by the Pennsylvania Division of the American Trauma Society (ATSPA). To nominate a **trauma staff nurse*** for this award, please complete the online nomination form following the link below.

The award winner will be given ATSPA conference registration at no cost (April 5-6, 2022), two nights' conference lodging at the Kalahari Resort and Convention Center, and travel expenses to attend the conference (i.e., vehicle mileage, tolls, and travel meals, **excluding** alcoholic beverages). The award winner will also receive a \$500 cash prize.

Also, the person making the winning nomination will receive complimentary conference registration (April 5-6, 2022).

The \$500 cash prize will be presented to the award recipient during the American Trauma Society, Pennsylvania Division's annual conference on Tuesday, April 5, 2022, at 8:30 am at the Kalahari Resort and Convention Center, in Pocono Manor, PA. **If, for some reason, the award recipient is unable to attend, it is expected that the nominator will attend the conference and accept the award on their behalf.** If nominator accepts the award on behalf of the award winner, the nominator will then receive complimentary two-night conference lodging.
